SESSION SUMMARIES

HR is a Marathon with Matt Jones: Matt is a three-time cancer survivor who has now become known as the Continental Marathon Man. He has completed marathons on eight different continents. He tells his incredible story of survival, picking yourself up, and staying motivated and positive when life kicks you in the teeth. Matt talks about the superpower of self-belief and ways to incorporate happiness into your life, both personal and professional. One of Matt's key phrases is "When it comes to your victory, it's your mindset that counts.

ADA Outreach with Maggie Sims: Maggie joined the RMADAC in 1992 as an ADA Information Specialist, with a deep interest in reducing communication barriers for those with hearing, speech, and visual losses. An expert on the ADA and effective communication processes and skilled in sign language, Maggie also provides guidance on technical assistance calls focused on helping the RMADAC's region, which includes Colorado, Montana, North Dakota, South Dakota, Utah and Wyoming.

Suicide Prevention & Awareness with Tauna Groomsmith: Wyoming suicide statistics are among the worst in the nation. Tauna willbe discussing employee mental health and suicide awareness amongst your employees. For example, how to spot when your employees are struggling with their mental health and potentially considering suicide. We will be looking into skill sets to spot these concerns and things we can potentially do as employers and colleagues to help and potentially even intervene.

HR Mavericks: The Team Edition with Jean Briese: Ready for something different? This is not your usual presentation. Through a fun "challenge" you will be up, moving and working in teams to complete a challenge. After all the teams complete the objective we will discuss in an informal group what we just experienced. You will have a few "AHA" moments about teamwork, collaboration, communication, DEIB, leadership, embracing change, and creating high performing teams and shattering status quo. Every attendee will take away new tools to use immediately.

5 Superpowers to be Extraordinary with Jean Briese: Are you ready to unleash your power and level up?
